Intern Job Description and Responsibilities: The intern will observe as well as participate in the preparation for simulation and clinical laboratory under the direct supervision of the Nurse Educator as approved by the Director of Practical Nursing. The internship will begin on May--- 2010 and end on August 1, 2010. The intern is responsible for working 16 hours a week.

Specific Criteria Required for Intern Position: Undergraduate nursing students with an interest in nursing education and exploring the professional role of Nurse Educator should apply for this internship. The eligible applicant must have completed their junior or senior year in an accredited undergraduate diploma, associate, or baccalaureate nursing program. The applicant must provide an official college transcript confirming the successful completion of one medical surgical clinical rotation in the acute care environment. Additionally, the applicant must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above. Each applicant must also provide documentation of compliance with NCSPON medical clearance requirements and two letters of reference. The first letter of recommendation should come from a clinical instructor and the second from a professional contact.
